Learn About Jazz

- Jazz developed in New Orleans, during the early 1900's.
- Improvisation, which is making things up on the spot, is an important part of jazz. Jazz musicians play solos which they make up right there- and that takes a lot of skill!
- At first, people mostly danced to jazz, and it wasn't until later that people just listened to it.
- The most common jazz instruments are horns, like the saxophone, trumpet, trombone, the piano, the bass, drums, and the guitar.
- Some famous jazz musicians are Louis Armstrong, Duke Ellington, Charlie Parker, and Miles Davis.
